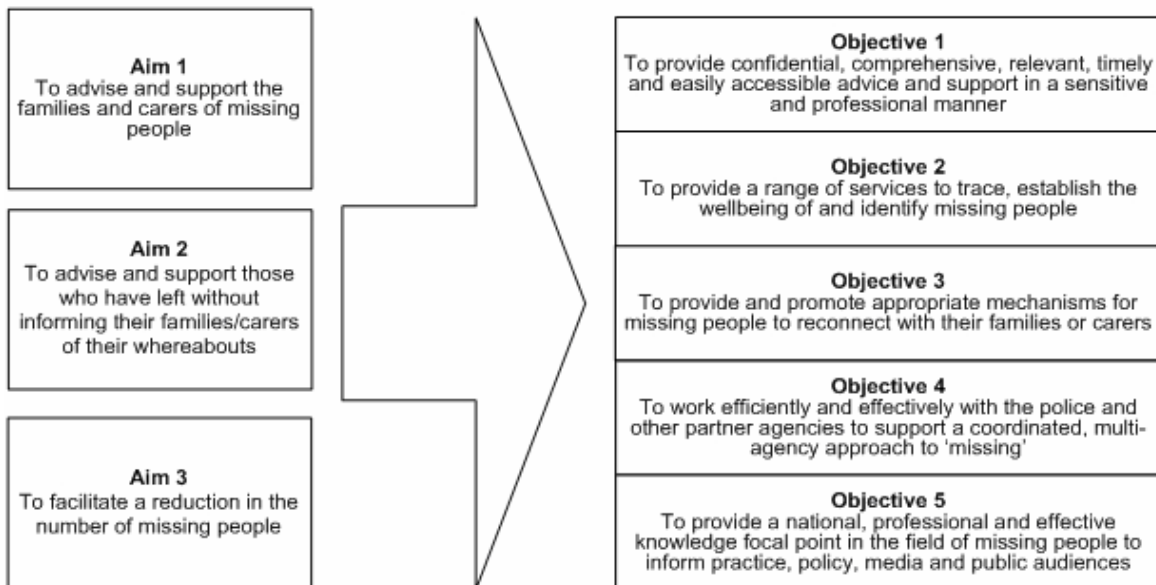
Aims and Objectives

Vision

A society that recognises the impact of 'missing' on individuals, families and communities and that coordinates its services and resources to support and empower those affected and those working in the arena

Mission

To advise and support people affected by "missing" and to facilitate a reduction in the numbers of missing people



Activities
Emotional Support
Confidential Helplines and online services providing emotional support for people who are out of contact with their family/carer or are affected by someone close to them going missing
Brokerage
An intermediary service between those missing, families, carers, Police, Social Services or other organisations
Investigation
Enquiries service using a wide range of agencies in the hope of reuniting or bringing closure to those searching
Publicity and Sightings
Poster production and distribution, age progression and image enhancement, 2D/3D reconstruction, national and local media appeals and features, and taking of sightings from the public
Advice
Able to establish the level of risk, explore options and advise accordingly
Referrals and Signposting
Refer the caller to another organisation and, when appropriate, making contact on behalf of the caller
Data Collection and Analysis
Compilation of the most comprehensive database of information about missing people enabling identification and analysis
Dissemination
Sharing of knowledge and information with practitioners, policy makers, voluntary organisations, media and other audiences
Partnership
Working collaboratively with government, public sector, voluntary and corporate partners
