Each local area will have their own template and process for completing Return Home Interviews (RHI) with children and young people. This is an example template created by Missing People. Each worker should check with their local area which template and process they should follow before undertaking any RHIs.

Notes on outcomes of RHI	 Prompts: Safeguarding concerns - specify these and note who with, how and when they were shared, name of social worker, family support worker, police staff etc. Any suggestions/recommendations/signposting information provided to child/young person/families/care staff and their reactions to receipt of this information? Any discussion around safety planning in the view of future incidents?
